

Rebuilding Together-AFF is Ramping Up Free Home Repairs

Over the past 36 years, Rebuilding Together Arlington/Fairfax/Falls Church has provided free home repairs to more than 2,800 homeowners and nonprofits. With our increased capacity, we're now able to help more homeowners and make deeper repairs.

Applications are Now Open for Arlington and Fairfax County residents to apply for home repairs and accessibility modifications. To qualify, you must:

- Own and live in your home
- Have a total gross household income that does not exceed \$68,500 for one person or \$78,250 for two people, with a sliding scale for larger households (slightly higher for Arlington).

Our Services Include:

- **Fall Safety and Aging in Place:** Installing grab bars, double handrails, comfort-height toilets, toilet safety rails, and brighter LED lighting.
- Assistance for Those with Disabilities and Limited Mobility: Installing exterior handrails, building wheelchair ramps, and installing electric stair lifts.
- General Home Repairs: Securing doors and windows; repairing hazardous dryer ducts; installing smoke and carbon monoxide alarms; sealing air leaks; replacing non-functioning appliances and leaking water heaters; making plumbing, electrical, and HVAC repairs; and fixing fences and gates.

Our Team: While we rely primarily on skilled volunteers, we engage corporate and faith-based teams for larger projects and hire professional contractors for complex repairs. Not every home is a good fit, and we can't fix every problem in every home, but we aim to help as many homeowners as possible.

Funding: Rebuilding Together-AFF receives funding for this Home Repair program from Fairfax County and Arlington County Community Development Block Grant as well private donations.
